Field Allowance

Determination 0209, Field Allowance, is amended—

- (a) by inserting at the end of the definition of “member” in clause 2 “, other than service in a Reserve component of an Integrated Field Force Unit”;
- (b) by inserting at the end of the definition of “Regular Field Force Unit” in clause 2 “and the Regular Army component of an Integrated Field Force Unit”;
- (c) by omitting “or” from sub-paragraph 3 (b) (i); and
- (d) by inserting after sub-paragraph 3 (b) (ii) the following word and sub-paragraph:
“; or (iii) is posted to a unit in the Townsville area, not being a Regular Field Force Unit for duty in a position which is designated on Army establishment tables as being an Operational Deployment Force position, and who is required in the ordinary course of the duties of that posting, to undergo training with the Operational Deployment Force on a regular basis.”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 69 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0209 provides for the payment of Field Allowance at daily and continuous rates to compensate members for the uncomfortable living and working conditions that they endure in the field whilst undergoing operational training.

This determination amends Determination 0209 to apply the continuous rate of the allowance in lieu of the daily rate to:

- a. Regular Army personnel serving with a Regular Army component of an Integrated Field Force Unit; and
- b. members of the Regular Army who are serving in the Townsville area in positions which are not in Field Force Units but are designated as Operational Deployment Force positions, and who are required in the ordinary course of their duties to undergo training in the field with the Operational Deployment Force.

The date of effect is the date of signature of the determination.
