- (b) paragraph 1 (b) of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 26 June 1986; and
- (c) paragraph 1 (c) of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 24 July 1986.

"7. Determination 3716, Supplementary Living Allowance, as amended by—

- (a) paragraph 3 (a) of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 29 May 1986;
- (b) paragraph 3 (b) of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 26 June 1986; and
- (c) paragraph 3 (c) of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 24 July 1986."

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 76 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3714 and 3716 provide respectively for the payment of Overseas Living Out Allowance (OLOA) and Supplementary Living Allowance (SLA) to a member of the Defence Force who is serving overseas. The allowances are provided to enable members to maintain a standard of living comparable to their standard in Australia.

The rates of OLOA and SLA for members serving on duty in Papua New Guinea (PNG) at other than the High Commission were subject to an increase with effect from 6 March 1986. The rates were subsequently found to be incorrect and in excess of those intended.

Determination No. 33 of 1986, in providing for the correct rates to be applied with effect from 29 May 1986, also operated to prescribe deflated rates which allowed for recovery, from that date, of overpayments caused by the promulgation of the incorrect rates.

Further increases to the rates of these allowances became effective from 26 June 1986 and 24 July 1986. This determination amends Determination No. 33 of 1986 to include these increases in clauses 1 and 3, and to adjust the deflated rates accordingly in clauses 2 and 4.
