Temporary Rental Allowance

1. Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, is amended—
- (a) by inserting in paragraph 13 (a) "Brisbane," after "Adelaide,";
 - (b) by inserting in paragraph 13 (a) "Gold Coast (members based at Canungra), Ipswich," after "Canberra (including Queanbeyan),";
 - (c) by omitting from paragraph 13 (b) "or Salisbury" and substituting ", Salisbury, Toowoomba or Townsville"; and
 - (d) by inserting at the end of the entry relating to Toowoomba in Schedule 2 the following rental ceilings and date:

"133 125 118 110 4 September 1986".

Application

2. Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, as amended by clause 1 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 4 September 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 95 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force who needs to rent accommodation for his or her family because a married quarter is not available. The rate of allowance is based on the difference between the weekly rental paid by the member (up to a specified rental ceiling applicable to the member) and a contribution by the member according to his or her rank group. In certain circumstances the determination permits an approving authority to increase the rental ceiling applicable to a member.

This determination amends Determination 0503 by increasing the amount by which an approving authority may approve an increase in the rental ceiling for a member who, due to family circumstances, is required to occupy a rented dwelling with more than 3 bedrooms:

- a. from a maximum of \$10.00 per week to a maximum of 15 percent of the normal limit where the member is residing in Brisbane, the Gold Coast or Ipswich; and
- b. from a maximum of \$10.00 per week to a maximum of 10 percent of the normal limit where the member is residing in Toowoomba or Townsville.

This determination further amends Determination 0503 by increasing the rental ceilings for Toowoomba.

The date of effect of all these changes is 4 September 1986.
