Airconditioning Allowance

1. Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance, is amended
 - (a) by inserting after "his" (wherever occurring) and "he" in the definition of "member" in clause 2 "or her" and "or she" respectively;
 - (b) by inserting after "his" in clause 4 "or her"; and
 - (c) by inserting in the table in clause 9 before the entry relating to Exmouth the following entry:

"Broome

— —
October, November,
December, January,
February, March,
April."

2. Paragraph 1 (c) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 1 December 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 96 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Defence Force serving in specified localities to reimburse the cost of operating airconditioning facilities fitted to their married quarters.

Paragraph 1(c) and clause 2 of this determination amend, with effect from 1 December 1986, Determination 0304 to include Broome, Western Australia, as a locality in respect of which Airconditioning Allowance is payable.

Paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) remove discriminatory language from the Determination.
