Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903

Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0105, Common Duties Allowance.¹

Definitions

2. In this Determination—

“Antarctica” includes Macquarie Island;

“member” means a member to whom Antarctic Allowance is payable under Determination 0305, Antarctic Allowance.

Interpretation

3. In this Determination a reference to a Determination is a reference to a Determination made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Common Duties Allowance

4. Where, on a day, a member is directed by an officer in charge of an official Australian National Antarctic Research Expedition to perform duties which are—

- (a) required to be carried out at a time when the member is accommodated ashore in Antarctica with such an expedition; and

(b) additional and unrelated to the ordinary duties of the member, and the member performs those additional duties, he or she is entitled to the payment of Common Duties Allowance of \$16.42 in respect of that day.

Allowance to be Payable Fortnightly

5. Common Duties Allowance payable to a member under this Determination accrues from day to day and is payable fortnightly.

Application

6. This Determination shall apply from and including 1 October 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 98 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0105, Common Duties Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members who perform Defence Force service in support of an official Australian National Antarctic Research Expedition and who, while accommodated ashore in Antarctica, are directed by the officer in charge of the expedition to perform duties additional and unrelated to those that the member would ordinarily be required to perform.

The allowance is a flow-on of an Australian Public Service allowance, and is payable at the rate of \$16.42 per day for each day on which members are required to perform additional duties.

The date of effect is 1 October 1986.
