



**Determination No. 1 of 1987**

**Determination under Section 58B of the  
Defence Act 1903<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)**

**Travelling Allowance**

1. Schedule 2 to Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, is amended as set out in the following table:

Item	Amendments		
1.	Omit the entry relating to Britain and substitute— "Britain. . . . . Pound . . . . .	6.15	6.75".
2.	Omit the entry relating to Germany and substitute— "Germany, Federal Republic of . . . . . Deutschmark . . . . .	27.00	30.00".
3.	Omit the entry relating to Hong Kong and substitute— "Hong Kong . . . . . Dollar . . . . .	84.00	92.00".
4.	Omit the entry relating to New Zealand and substitute— "New Zealand . . . . . Dollar . . . . .	7.90	8.70".
5.	Omit the entry relating to the Philippines and substitute— "Philippines . . . . . Peso . . . . .	128.00	128.00".

**Education Assistance Overseas**

2. The Schedule to Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, is amended by—

(a) omitting from Part 2 the entry relating to Hong Kong and substituting—

"Hong Kong . . . British Military Schools; ESF Schools"; and

- (b) omitting from Part 3 the entry relating to Hong Kong and substituting—  
“Hong Kong . . . British Military Schools; ESF Schools”.

### **Application**

3. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, as amended by—

- (a) item 1 of the table in clause 1—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 6 September 1985;
- (b) item 3 of the table in clause 1—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 30 September 1985;
- (c) item 4 of the table in clause 1—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 2 December 1985;
- (d) item 5 of the table in clause 1—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 14 April 1986; and
- (e) item 2 of the table in clause 1—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 11 June 1986.

### **Transitional**

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 2 of this Determination, where—

- (a) a member was entitled to receive Education Assistance Overseas under Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*—
  - (i) by reason of the attendance of his or her child or children at the International School, Hong Kong; or
  - (ii) at a rate which was dependent upon the International School, Hong Kong, being an approved primary or secondary school within the meaning of Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas; and
- (b) that child or those children continue to attend the same school referred to in paragraph (a) on and after the date on which this Determination is made,

the member shall be entitled to receive Education Assistance Overseas to and including the day that child or those children cease to attend that primary or secondary school as if clause 2 of this Determination had not been made.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 1 OF 1987

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance which reimburses the additional travelling costs incurred by a member of the Defence Force serving on duty overseas.

Clauses 1 and 3 of this determination amend Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, to increase the rate of allowance payable to a member who is required to live-in in Service accommodation while on temporary duty overseas in:

- a. Britain, with effect from 6 September 1985;
- b. Germany, with effect from 11 June 1986;
- c. Hong Kong, with effect from 30 September 1985;
- d. New Zealand, with effect from 2 December 1985; or
- e. the Philippines, with effect from 14 April 1986.

Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, provides for financial assistance to a member of the Defence Force who is posted overseas for more than 6 months and who incurs certain costs in the education of a child overseas.

Clause 2 of this determination amends Determination 3725 by omitting, with effect from the date this determination is signed, the International School, Hong Kong, as an approved school for the payment of certain education expenses.

Clause 4 has been included to preserve the position of any member who is adversely affected by the omission of the International School, Hong Kong, as an approved school. The clause allows for the continued recognition of this school as an approved school for calculating payment of the allowance to a member whose child or children attend:

- a. the International School; or
- b. another school in Hong Kong which is dependent upon the level of charges at the International School for the payment of the allowance,

prior to the date on which this determination was signed.
