Gratuities

Determination 0705, Gratuities, is amended by omitting paragraphs 5 (a) and 5 (b) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- “(a) Assistant Director, Operations Sub-section, Defence Force Retirement and Death Benefits Section, Australian Government Retirement Benefits Office;
- (b) Director, Defence Force Retirement and Death Benefits Section, Australian Government Retirement Benefits Office; or”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION No. 29 OF 1987

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0705, Gratuities, provides for the payment of gratuities to serving members who are not entitled to pensions or invalidity benefits under the Defence Force Retirement and Death Benefits legislation.

This determination amends Determination 0705 to change two approving authorities for the purpose of the Determination as the currently named authorities no longer exist. The date of effect is the date on which the determination is signed.
