District Allowance

1. Determination 0301, District Allowance, is amended by inserting in the table in clause 5 after the entry relating to Tom. Price the following entry:

"Walker Island D".

Temporary Rental Allowance

2. Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, is amended—
- (a) by inserting in paragraph 13 (a) "Cairns," after "Brisbane,"; and
 - (b) by inserting in paragraph 13 (a) "Gosford," after "Gold Coast (members based at Canungra),".

Application

3. Determination 0301, District Allowance, as amended by clause 1 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 20 May 1987.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 49 OF 1988

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0301, District Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to members of the Defence Force serving in certain localities specified as isolated districts because of their remoteness, extreme climatic conditions and the high cost of living.

Clauses 1 and 3 of this determination amend Determination 0301 to specify Walker Island as a grade D isolated district attracting payment of the highest rate of allowance. The date of effect of this change is 20 May 1987, the date on which a Navy survey vessel first went to the locality.

Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force where the member and family are moved at Commonwealth expense from one locality to another in Australia and they are obliged to rent accommodation because a married quarter is not available. The rate of allowance is based on the difference between the weekly rental paid by the member (up to a specified rental ceiling applicable to the member) and a contribution by the member according to his or her rank group.

Clause 2 of this determination amends Determination 0503 by increasing, from a maximum of \$10.00 per week to a maximum of 15

percent of the normal rental ceiling, the amount by which an approving authority may approve an increase in the rental ceiling for a member residing in Cairns or Gosford who, due to family circumstances, is required to occupy a rented dwelling with more than 3 bedrooms. The date of effect of the amendment is the date of signature of the determination.
