**Application**

7. Clause 1 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 4 December 1987.

8. Clause 2 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 25 November 1987.

9. Clauses 3, 4 and 5 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 December 1987.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 7 OF 1988

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS  
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0402, Vehicle Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) who are authorised to use their privately owned vehicles on travel which would otherwise be at Commonwealth expense.

Clauses 1 and 7 of this Determination amend Determination 0402 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 4 December 1987.

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to assist a member of the ADF with unreimbursed costs associated with a removal at the time of a posting from one locality to another locality and the accelerated depreciation of furniture and effects caused by constant removals at Commonwealth expense.

Clauses 2 and 8 of this Determination amend Determination 0505 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 25 November 1987.

Determination 0509, Dwelling Purchase or Sale Expenses Allowance, provides assistance to a member who purchases or sells a dwelling when posted from one locality to another. Assistance is in the form of reimbursement of some or all of the unavoidable legal and real estate costs associated with the purchase or sale.

Clauses 3 and 9 of this Determination amend Determination 0509 to increase from 1 December 1987 the maximum value of the house and of the mortgage in respect of which the allowance for purchase or sale will be calculated.

Determinations 0604 and 0606 provide respectively for the payment of:

- a. Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members; and
- b. Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments,

to members of the ADF to compensate them for the costs they incur in outfitting themselves with, and maintaining, uniforms and other clothing requirements.

Clauses 4, 5 and 9 of this Determination amend Determinations 0604 and 0606 to increase the rates of these allowances with effect from 1 December 1987.

Determination 2501; Charge for Rations and Quarters, obliges a member of the ADF, including Reserve members where appropriate, to pay for rations and quarters used by the member when living in service accommodation, except in certain circumstances.

Paragraph 6(a) of this Determination amends Determination 2501 to increase the charges from the date on which this Determination is made.

Paragraph 6(b) of this Determination amends Determination 2501 to permit waiver of the charge for members undergoing the punishment of detention or in custody, and to omit the waiver provisions for members under suspension with effect from the date of signature of the Determination.
