EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 79 OF 1988

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

The following determinations provide for the payment of allowances to members of the Defence Force who are serving on duty overseas to reimburse their travelling and meal costs or to enable them to maintain a standard of living in an overseas country comparable to their standard in Australia by reimbursing the additional costs incurred because of that overseas service:

- a. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance;
- b. Determination 3610, In Port Allowance;
- c. Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out Allowance;
- d. Determination 3719, Post Allowance;
- e. Determination 3731, Meal Allowance Overseas;
- f. Determination 3732, Overseas Vehicle Allowance; and
- g. Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas.

Clauses 1, 2 and 11 of this determination amend Determination 3601:

- a. by introducing, with effect from 8 December 1988, within country travelling rates for members travelling in Spain;

- b. by increasing, with effect from 24 November 1988, the category C rates of this allowance payable to members serving in Zambia;
- c. by increasing, with effect from 8 December 1988, certain other rates payable to members serving in Spain and Switzerland; and
- d. by omitting, with effect from the date on which the determination is signed, the category B rates of this allowance payable to members serving in Zambia.

Clauses 3 and 12 of this determination amend Determination 3610 by increasing, with effect from 8 December 1988, the rates payable to members serving in Spain.

Clause 4 of this determination amends Determination 3711 by omitting, with effect from the date on which the determination is signed, the rates applicable to Berne in Switzerland as there are no members of the Defence Force posted there on intermediate or long term duty.

Clause 5 of this determination amends Determination 3719, with effect from the date on which the determination is signed, to remove the provision relating to the payment of this allowance for Male in the Maldives as this locality no longer attracts the payment of Post Allowance.

Clauses 6 and 13 of this determination amend Determination 3731 by increasing, with effect from 8 December 1988, the rates payable to members serving in Spain.

Clause 7 of this determination amends Determination 3732 by decreasing, with effect from 5 January 1989, the rates payable to members serving in Honolulu in the United States of America (USA).

Clauses 10 and 14 of this determination amend Determination 3901 by increasing, with effect from 10 November 1988, the amount of Household Maintenance and Assistance Allowance payable to members serving in Honolulu in the USA.

A member of the Defence Force who is serving on duty overseas for more than 6 months and who is provided with a motor vehicle by the Commonwealth for his or her private use, or with official transport to and from work or for the transport of his or her children to and from school, is required to contribute a specified amount or amounts for the use of that motor vehicle or official transport. Determination 3733, Overseas Vehicle Contribution, provides for the contribution to be paid by the member to the Commonwealth.

Clauses 8 and 9 of this determination amend Determination 3733 by decreasing, with effect from 10 November 1988, the contributions payable by members serving in Honolulu in the USA.
