Vehicle Allowance

1. Determination 0402, Vehicle Allowance, is amended by omitting from column 3 of the table in clause 21 -

- (a) "40.1" and substituting "42.0";
- (b) "38.8" and substituting "40.6";
- (c) "33.8" and substituting "35.4"; and
- (d) "28.9" and substituting "30.3".

Attendance Allowance

2. Determination 0499, Attendance Allowance, is amended -

- (a) by omitting from paragraph 3(a) "\$2.25" and substituting "\$2.40";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph 3(b) "\$4.05" and substituting "\$4.35";

- (c) by omitting from paragraph 3(c) "\$5.30" and substituting "\$5.70"; and
- (d) by omitting from paragraph 3(d) "\$7.40" and substituting "\$7.95".

Disturbance Allowance

3. Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, is amended by omitting the table from clause 8 and substituting the following table:

Dwelling Purchase or Sale Expenses Allowance

4. Determination 0509, Dwelling Purchase or Sale Expenses Allowance, is amended -

- (a) by omitting from clause 34 "\$49,000" (wherever occurring) and substituting "\$51,200"; and
- (b) by omitting from clause 34 "\$119,900" (wherever occurring) and substituting "\$125,200".

Child Care Reimbursement Allowance

5. Determination 0510, Child Care Reimbursement Allowance, is amended -

- (a) by inserting after "Commonwealth" in the definition of "removal" in clause 2 "and includes a removal within Australia resulting from a posting from Australia to an overseas locality or from an overseas locality to Australia but does not include a posting from one overseas locality to another; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph 7(b) "\$20.00" and substituting "\$22.50".

Extra Tuition Allowance

6. Determination 0511, Extra Tuition Allowance, is amended by omitting from paragraph 5(b) "\$40.00" and substituting "\$44.50".

Uniform Maintenance Allowance

7. Determination 0601, Uniform Maintenance Allowance, is amended -

- (a) by omitting from clause 3 "\$481" (wherever occurring) and substituting "\$525";

(b) by omitting from paragraph 3(b) "\$295" and substituting "\$322"; and

(c) by omitting from paragraph 3(e) "\$356" and substituting "\$389".

Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members

8. Determination 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members, is amended by omitting from clause 2 "\$272" and substituting "\$293".

Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments

9. Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, is amended by omitting the table from clause 3 and substituting the following table:

Charge for Rations and Quarters

10. Determination 2501, Charge for Rations and Quarters is amended by omitting from column 3 of the table in clause 6 -

(a) "6.85" (twice occurring) and substituting, in each case, "7.20";

(b) "8.45" and substituting "8.90"; and

(c) "9.15" and substituting "9.60".

Application

11. Clause 1 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 4 December 1988.

12. Clause 2 of this Determination shall apply in relation to reserve service rendered by a member on or after 1 December 1988.

13. Clause 3 of this Determination shall apply in relation to a removal undertaken by a member on or after 29 November 1988.

14. Clauses 4, 6, 8 and 9, and paragraph 5 (b) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 December 1988.

15. Clause 7 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 8 December 1988.

16. Clause 10 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 5 January 1989.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 80 OF 1988

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0402, Vehicle Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) who are authorized to use their privately owned vehicles on travel which would otherwise be at Commonwealth expense.

Clauses 1 and 11 of this determination amend Determination 0402 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 4 December 1988.

Determination 0499, Attendance Allowance, Determination 0509, Dwelling Purchase or Sale Expenses Allowance, Determination 0510, Child Care Reimbursement Allowance, and Determination 0511, Extra Tuition Allowance, provide for payment of allowances to members of the ADF to, respectively:

- a. assist members of the Defence Force Reserve with the cost of travel between their usual place of residence and their place of duty;
- b. reimburse some or all of the unavoidable legal and real estate costs associated with the purchase or sale of a dwelling;
- c. reimburse costs incurred for child minding when, because of Service reasons or other acceptable reasons, only one adult member of the family can be present during a removal; and

- d. partly recompense for costs incurred when, as a result of transfer to a new locality, a member's child suffers short term detriment to schooling and requires professional tuition in certain academic subjects.

Determination 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members, and Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, provide for the payment of allowances to members of the ADF to compensate them for the costs they incur in outfitting themselves with uniforms and other clothing requirements.

Clauses 2, 4, 6, 8, 9, 12, 14 and paragraph 5(b) of this determination amend Determinations 0499, 0509, 0510, 0511, 0604 and 0606 to increase the rates of these allowances with effect from 1 December 1988.

The opportunity has also been taken in paragraph 5(a) to amend Determination 0510 to clarify the definition of "removal" from the date on which this determination is made.

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to assist a member of the ADF with unreimbursed costs associated with the removal at the time of posting and accelerated depreciation of furniture and effects caused by constant removals at Commonwealth expense.

Clauses 3 and 13 amend Determination 0505 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 29 November 1988.

Determination 0601, provides for payment of Uniform Maintenance Allowance to members of the ADF to assist them to maintain their uniforms in good order and condition.

Clauses 7 and 15 amend Determination 0601 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 8 December 1988.

Determination 2501, Charge for Rations and Quarters, obliges a member of the ADF, including a member of the Reserve Force where appropriate, to pay for the rations and quarters used by

the member when provided with Service accommodation and meals.

Clauses 10 and 16 amend Determination 2501 to increase the charge with effect from 5 January 1989.
