DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1989/109.

Adjustment of rates of Overseas Vehicle Allowance

2. Where a member was entitled to be paid Overseas Vehicle Allowance for the use, in a country specified in column 1 of Table 1 to this determination, of a private vehicle in accordance with Defence Determination 3732, Overseas Vehicle Allowance, the member shall be entitled to be paid an allowance equal to the difference between the amount of the Overseas Vehicle Allowance the member was entitled to be paid and the amount the member would have been entitled to be paid if, for the country so specified, the rates of allowance specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Table opposite to the locality had been in force with effect for the period specified in column 5 of the entry in the Table.

Adjustment of rates of Overseas Vehicle Contribution

3. Where a member was required in accordance with Defence Determination 3733, Overseas Vehicle Contribution, to pay Overseas Vehicle Contribution for the use of a vehicle, provided by the Commonwealth, in a country specified in column 1 of Table 2 to this determination, the amount of the contribution required of the member shall be reduced by an amount equal to the difference between the amount of the Overseas Vehicle Contribution the member was required to pay and the amount the member would have been required to pay if, for the country so specified, the rates of contribution specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Table opposite to the locality had been in force with effect for the period specified in column 5 of the entry in the Table.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 109 OF 1989

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3732, Overseas Vehicle Allowance, and Determination 3733, Overseas Vehicle Contribution, to provide for the adjustment of rates of vehicle allowances and contributions applying to members of the Defence Force who are serving overseas in line with rates determined for Australian Public Service staff serving overseas.

Arrangements have now been made to minimise the need for retrospective variations to overseas allowances for members of the Defence Force.
