EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 13 OF 1989

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance where a member and family are moved at Commonwealth from one locality to another locality within Australia and they are obliged to rent accommodation at the new locality. The rate of allowance payable to the member is based on a maximum level of reimbursement of rental costs incurred by the member (the rental ceiling) less a specified contribution by that member towards that rental.

This determination amends Determination 0503 to increase, with effect from 10 November 1988, the rental ceilings listed in Schedule 2 to that determination for the Adelaide, Brisbane, Darwin, Hobart, Melbourne, Perth and Sydney localities.
