EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 4 OF 1989

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

The following determinations provide for the payment of allowances to members of the Defence Force who are serving on duty overseas to enable them to maintain a standard of living in an overseas country comparable to their standard in Australia by reimbursing the additional costs incurred because of that overseas service:

- a. Determination 3714, Overseas Living Allowance;
- b. Determination 3718, Overseas Rental and Utilities Allowance;
- c. Determination 3723, Reunion Supplement; and
- d. Determination 3724, Child Supplement.

Clause 1 of this determination amends Determination 3714 by decreasing, with effect from 16 February 1989, the rates payable to members serving in the Lebanon (where the member is serving in Beirut and the family is residing in Egypt).

Clauses 2 and 5 of this determination amend Determination 3718 by decreasing, with effect from 16 February 1989, the rent ceilings applicable to members serving with the United Nations in Egypt.

Clauses 3 and 4 of this determination amend Determinations 3723 and 3724, respectively, by decreasing, with effect from 16 February 1989, the rates payable to members serving in Egypt.
