**DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903**

**Citation**

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1989/49.

**Commencement**

2. Clause 8 of this determination shall be deemed to have come into operation immediately before Overseas Defence Determination 1989/40 comes into operation.

3. The remaining provisions of this determination shall come into operation on the first day of the pay period commencing on or after the date of signature of this determination.

**Rates of Travelling Allowance - Zimbabwe**

4. Determination 3601, as in force<sup>1</sup>, is amended by -

- (a) omitting from Schedules 1 and 3 the rates of allowance in relation to the locality specified in Table 1 to this determination and substituting respectively the rates set out in Parts A and C of that table; and
- (b) inserting in Schedule 2, in alphabetical order according to Country, the entry set out in Part B of Table 1.

**Rates of In Port Allowance - Zimbabwe**

5. Determination 3610, as in force<sup>1</sup>, is amended by inserting in the table in clause 5, in alphabetical order according to Country, the entry set out in Table 2 to this determination.

**Settling In and Settling Out Allowance - Zimbabwe**

6. Determination 3711, as in force<sup>1</sup>, is amended by inserting in the schedule after item 41, the item set out in Table 3 to this determination.

**Rates of Meal Allowance - Zimbabwe**

7. Determination 3731, as in force<sup>1</sup>, is amended by omitting from the schedule the rates of allowance in relation to the locality specified in Table 4 to this determination and substituting the rates set out in that table.

**Settling In and Settling Out Allowance - Bangladesh**

8. Overseas Defence Determination 1989/40 is amended by omitting "88.00" from Table 3 and substituting "188.00".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 49 OF 1989

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determinations:

- 3601 - Travelling Allowance
- 3610 - In Port Allowance
- 3711 - Settling In and Settling Out Allowance
- 3731 - Meal Allowance

The amendment provides for the payment of revised rates of allowances to members of the Defence Force who are serving overseas in line with rates determined for Australian Public Service staff serving overseas.

The amendment of Overseas Defence Determination 1989/40 made by clause 8 is to correct a clerical error in the rate of an allowance applicable to members in Bangladesh and is brought into operation to correct the error from the date on which it first occurred.
