DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1989/69.

Commencement

2. This determination shall come into operation on the first day of the pay period commencing on or after the date of signature of this determination.

Principal Determination

3. In this determination, Determination 3718 as in force¹ is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Approving Authority

4.1 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting after clause 6 the following clause -

"6A. The approving authority for the purpose of clause 27A shall be the person from time to time holding or performing the duties of an office in the Department of Industrial Relations titled Assistant Secretary, APS Overseas Conditions Branch, Australian Government Employment Remuneration and Conditions Division".

4.2 Clause 7 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "27A".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 69 OF 1989

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3718 (Overseas Rental and Utilities Allowance) by providing for the Assistant Secretary, APS Conditions Branch of the Australian Government Employment Remuneration and Conditions Division to exercise the role of approving authority in relation to periods of rent overlap.

This provision has been introduced as an interim arrangement to enable cases to be resolved pending a general revision of approving authorities in all determinations.
