**Citation**

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 3991, Namibia Allowance.

**Namibia Allowance**

2. A member of the Defence Force who is serving with the Australian Contingent United Nations Transition Assistance Group in Namibia shall be paid a Namibia Allowance at the rate of Rand 25.00 per day from and including the day on which the member arrives in that locality to and including the day he or she departs from that locality.

**Application**

3. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 February 1989.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 7 OF 1989

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3991, Namibia Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Defence Force to compensate for disabilities associated with service with the United Nations Transition Assistance Group (UNTAG) in Namibia.

The date of effect of the determination is 1 February 1989, the date on which it is expected that the first Defence Force personnel will have gone to Namibia.
