Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1989/79.

Commencement

2. This determination shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 June 1989 and shall cease to have effect at the expiration of 31 August 1989.

Beijing - Post Allowance

3. Notwithstanding sub-clause 6(c) of Determination 3719, Post Allowance, for the purposes of payment of Post Allowance Beijing in China shall be taken to be a Group 1 Locality.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 79 OF 1989

Defence Act 1903

For the purposes of payment of Post Allowance, this determination upgrades Beijing in China from Group 2 to Group 1 for a period of three months.

This temporary upgrading is in line with that determined for Australian Public Service staff serving in Beijing, and has the same dates of effect.
