DISTURBANCE ALLOWANCE

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, is amended by inserting in clause 11 "to a new locality" after "all removals" (first occurring).

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 99 OF 1989

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to assist members with unreimbursed costs associated with removals and accelerated depreciation of furniture and effects caused by repeated removals at Commonwealth expense at the time of a posting from one locality to another. For a member with family the amount payable is dependent upon the number of removals previously undertaken.

This determination amends Determination 0505 to exclude the counting of any previous removals within a locality when determining the number of prior removals a member has had for the purposes of establishing the amount of Disturbance Allowance payable.
