EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 109 OF 1990

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance where a member and family are moved at Commonwealth expense from one locality to another locality within Australia and they are obliged to rent accommodation at the new locality. The rate of allowance payable to the member is based on a maximum level of reimbursement of rental costs (the rental ceiling) incurred by the member.

This determination amends Determination 0503 to increase with effect from 5 July 1990, the rental ceilings listed in Schedule 2 to that determination for the Canberra (including Queanbeyan), Ipswich, and Nowra localities.
