DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1990/169.

Commencement

2.1 Sub-clause 4.1 of this determination is to be taken to have commenced on 7 June 1990.

2.2 Sub-clause 4.2 of this determination is to be taken to have commenced on 21 September 1990.

Principal Determination

3. In this determination Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as in force¹ is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Excess vehicle depreciation

4.1 Clause 175A of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting the Table and substituting the following Table -

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 169 OF 1990

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas by increasing the levels of supplementary allowance payable to members of the Australian Defence Force who are serving in Thailand who incur excess car depreciation.

The increased rates are identical to the rates of allowance under the Public Service Act 1922 for officers of the Australian Public Service performing duty on long-term posting in Thailand. The increased rates of allowance are effective from 7 June 1990, in line with the date the Australian Public Service rates came into operation.

The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
