



DETERMINATION NO. 17 OF 1990

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

I, RUTH ALISON CAMPBELL, First Assistant Secretary, Australian Government Employment Remuneration and Conditions Division, Department of Industrial Relations, pursuant to a delegation made by the Minister of State for Industrial Relations under Defence Force Regulation 72A, hereby make the following Determination under section 58B of the Defence Act 1903.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1990/17.

Principal Determination

2. In this determination Defence Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, as in force is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Approving authority

3. Clause 5 of the Principal Determination is amended by -

- (a) omitting "clause 4, 13, 14, 15, 21, 23, 27, 31, 40, 42, 44, 45, 46, 51, 58 or 59" from paragraph (a) and substituting "clause 4, 13, 14, 15, 21, 23, 27, 31, 44, 45, 46, 51 or 59"
- (b) omitting "clause 21, 40, 42, 46 or 58" from paragraph (b) and substituting "clause 21 or 46"; and
- (c) omitting "clauses 4, 21, 23, 40, 42, 45, 46 and 58" from paragraph (c) and substituting "clauses 4, 21, 23, 45 and 46".

Reimbursement for excess expenses

4. The Principal Determination is amended by omitting clause 58 and substituting the following clause -

"58.1 Where the Chief of the Defence Force is satisfied, having regard to -

- (a) the nature and level of expenses a member incurs for meals and incidental expenses during a period of short term duty;
- (b) the duration of the period of such duty;
- (c) the nature of the duties being undertaken during the period;
- (d) the cost of meals and relevant services at the localities visited by the officer during the period; and
- (e) any other relevant factor,

that the amount of travelling allowance payable to the member in respect of the period is insufficient to meet expenses necessarily incurred by the member during the period, other than such expenses for accommodation, the member shall be entitled to be reimbursed an amount equal to the difference between the amount of expenses so incurred and the amount of travelling allowance payable to the member in respect of the period.

"58.2 In this clause a reference to the Chief of the Defence Force shall be read as including a reference to a person authorised by the Chief of the Defence Force for the purpose of this clause."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 17 OF 1990

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, by revising and extending the provisions under which excess travelling allowance expenses are paid. The amendment reflects similar changes which have been made in the provisions applying to officers of the Australian Public Service in similar circumstances.
