**Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹
(Amendment)**

Expense of Office Allowance

1. Determination 0214, Expense of Office Allowance, is amended by omitting the definition of "member" from clause 2 and substituting the following definition:

"member" means a member who holds the rank of Commodore, Rear Admiral, Brigadier, Major General, Air Commodore or Air Vice Marshal, or is a Principal Naval Chaplain, a Principal Chaplain or a Principal Air Chaplain, and who is:

- (a) in receipt of salary for that rank or classification as specified in column 4 of Schedule 3 or 4 of Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members, as the case may be; and
- (b) rendering continuous full-time service;"

Application

2. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 February 1990.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 18 OF 1990

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal, in a recent decision, has subsumed Expense of Office Allowance in the salary rates for certain officers of Brigadier and Major General and equivalent ranks. Medical and Dental Officers and Chaplains at these ranks are not affected by this decision and will continue to be paid the allowance.

This Determination amends Determination 0214, Expense of Office Allowance, to preclude payment to those members who are no longer entitled to receive the allowance separately. The date of effect is the date of effect of Determination No. 1 of 1990 made by the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal under Section 58H of the Defence Act 1903.
