**Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹
(Amendment)**

Disturbance Allowance

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, is amended -

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "residence" in clause 2 the following definition:

"'sea-going ship' means a ship which is a sea-going ship for the purposes of Determination No. 1 of 1988, Sea-going Allowance, made under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*, as varied from time to time by the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal;"

- (b) by omitting from clause 7 "15,";
- (c) by omitting from sub-paragraph 7(a)(i)(C) "after the original removal to that locality";

- (d) by inserting in sub-paragraph 7(a)(ii) "or within the same locality" after "new locality";
 - (e) by inserting in PART II of the table in clause 8 -
 - "From living in to living in 75" after
 - "From living in to living out in a residence 145";
 - (f) by omitting clause 15;
 - (g) by omitting from paragraph 24(c) "or"; and
 - (h) by inserting after paragraph 24(d) the following word and paragraph:
 - "; or (e) a member in respect of a removal -
 - (i) from living in to living in accommodation within an establishment, unit, base or military area; or
 - (ii) between one sea-going ship and another sea-going ship when both ships have the same home port."

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 2 OF 1990

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

Determination 0505, Disturbance Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to assist members of the ADF with unreimbursed costs associated with removals and accelerated depreciation of furniture and effects caused by repeated removals at Commonwealth expense.

Paragraphs (c) and (f) amend Determination 0505 by removing the provision that to obtain the allowance for a move within a locality a member with family must have received the allowance on the initial move into the locality. Paragraph (d) provides for payment of "the relocation of a full-time student child" element of the allowance, when necessary, because of a move within a locality.

Paragraph (e) further amends Determination 0505 to specify the rate of the allowance applicable to a member without family who moves from living in to living in accommodation in another locality.

Paragraphs (a), (b), (g) and (h) make consequential amendments to Determination 0505.

The date of effect for these changes is the date of signature of this Determination.
