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**Expense of Office Allowance**

Determination 0214, Expense of Office Allowance, is amended by omitting clause 5 and substituting the following clause:

"5. Subject to clause 10, an allowance called "Expense of Office Allowance" is payable to a member who holds the rank of -

- (a) Commodore, Brigadier or Air Commodore, or a member who is a Principal Naval Chaplain, a Principal Chaplain or a Principal Air Chaplain - at the rate of \$1126 per year; and
- (b) Rear Admiral, Major General or Air Vice Marshal - at the rate of \$1873 per year."

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EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 3 OF 1990

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

As a result of a decision of the Industrial Relations Commission, Expense of Office Allowance is no longer paid to Senior Executive Service Officer of the Australian Public Service. The current determination applies the existing Australian Public Service rates as an automatic procedure but from the date of the Commissions' decision, these rates will no longer exist.

This amendment inserts the existing rates in the Determination.
