EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 79 OF 1990

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Sections 58B and 58E of the Defence Act 1903 allow the Minister or his delegate to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 2501, Charge for Rations and Quarters, obliges a member of the Defence Force, including a member of the Reserve Force where appropriate, to pay for the Rations and Quarters used by the member when provided with Service accommodation and meals.

This determination amends Determination 2501 to increase the charge from 5 July 1990.
