DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1991/10.

Principal Determination

2. In this determination Overseas Defence Determination 1989/27 as in force¹ is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Emergency evacuation

3 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following clause after clause 23B -

"23C. Where the Commonwealth arranges the temporary evacuation of a child of a member from the member's locality of posting to another overseas locality, this Determination applies in relation to the member as if the member were on long-term posting to that other locality during the period for which the child is evacuated."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 10 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Overseas Defence Determination 1989/27 by applying the existing provisions on education assistance in relation to officers of the Australian Public Service whose children are temporarily evacuated by the Commonwealth from the locality of posting to another overseas locality.

This provision is in line with that determined for Australian Public Service staff serving overseas.
