DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Commencement

1. This determination comes into operation on the same day as Defence Determination 1991/13.

Determination 606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments (Repeal)

2. Determination 606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments, as in force¹ is repealed.

Transitional

3.1 Any payment for additional clothing for the member made to a member in accordance with Defence Determination 606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments, is to be counted for the purpose of Defence Determination 1991/13 as if it had been made under clause 4 under the latter determination.

3.2 Any payment for additional clothing for the spouse of the Military Secretary/Comptroller made to a member in accordance with Defence Determination 606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments, is to be counted for the purpose of Defence Determination 1991/13 as if it had been made under clause 6 under the latter determination.

NOTE

1. Determination 606 was made by Determination 6 of 1981 and has been amended by Determinations 38 of 1981, 36 of 1982, 5 of 1984, 4 and 69 of 1985, 7, 31 and 32 of 1986, 1, 7 and 80 of 1988, 35 and 191 of 1989 and 77 of 1990.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DETERMINATION NO. 14 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination repeals Defence Determination 606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments as result of the introduction of revised arrangements by Defence Determination 1991/13.

Clause 3 provides a transitional arrangement for payments under the repealed determination to be counted as payments under Defence Determination 1991/13.
