**Commencement**

2. This determination is to be taken to have commenced on 1 January 1991.

**Principal Determination**

3. In this determination Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as in force<sup>1</sup> is referred to as the Principal Determination.

**Club allowance**

4. Sub-clause 36A.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "31 December 1990" and substituting "31 December 1991".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

**DETERMINATION NO. 15 OF 1991**

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, by extending the existing club membership provisions to 31 December 1991 for members of the Australian Defence Force who are serving in Beijing, China. This determination is in line with provisions determined for Australian Public Service staff serving in Beijing, China.

The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
