3. The Principal Determination is amended by omitting "31 March 1991" from sub-clause 2.1 and substituting "31 May 1991".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 37 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Overseas Defence Determination 1990/191 of 21 December 1990 ('the Principal Determination') by changing the date of repeal of clause 7A of Determination 3721, Rent and Utilities Contribution, from 31 March 1991 to 31 May 1991.

Clause 7A of Determination 3721 authorises remission of rent and utilities contributions for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) occupying sub-standard accommodation at specified localities.

As a result of changes to Overseas Living Allowance and related provisions brought about by the Principal Determination, ADF members became subject to new remission provisions authorised for officers of the Australian Public Service by Public Service Determination 1990/229.

Action has therefore been taken to repeal clause 7A of Determination 3721, but further time is needed to consider suitable provisions for ADF members who are currently on overseas postings at the localities in question.
