### DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

#### Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1991/54.

#### Commencement

2. This determination is to be taken to have commenced on 13 May 1991.

#### Excess baggage allowance

3. Clause 128 of Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as in force<sup>1</sup>, is amended by omitting "Brisbane" (twice occurring) and substituting "Sydney".

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**DETERMINATION NO. 54 OF 1991**

*Defence Act 1903*

This determination amends Determinations 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, by substituting Sydney for Brisbane, as the locality for approved leave for the payment of an excess baggage allowance for members of the Australian Defence Force serving in Papua New Guinea.

This amendment is in line with provision applying to Australian Public Service staff serving in Papua New Guinea.

The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
