



DETERMINATION NO 64 OF 1991

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

I, RUTH ALISON CAMPBELL, First Assistant Secretary, Remuneration and Conditions Division, Department of Industrial Relations, pursuant to a delegation made by the Minister of State for Industrial Relations under Defence Force Regulation 72A, hereby make the following Determination under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1991/64.

Commencement

2. This determination commences on the first day of the pay period commencing on or after the date of signature of this determination.

Education assistance – United States of America

3. Overseas Defence Determination 1989/27, as in force¹ is amended by omitting sub-clause 18.1(a), (b) and (c) and substituting the following:

- "(a) in the case of a child who attends pre-school –
 - (i) if the officer has been directed to reside on Manhattan Island – US\$6800; and
 - (ii) if the officer is not required to so reside – US\$3755;
- (b) in the case of a child who attends primary school –
 - (i) if the officer has been directed to reside on Manhattan Island – US\$10030;
 - (ii) if the officer has not been so directed and resides in New York State – US\$8755;
 - (iii) if the officer is required to reside in the District of Columbia and the officer so resides – US\$10010; and
 - (iv) if the officer resides elsewhere in the United States of America – US\$7505; and
- (c) in the case of a child who attends secondary school –
 - (i) if the officer has been directed to reside on Manhattan Island – US\$11030;
 - (ii) if the officer has not been so directed and resides in New York State – US\$8755;
 - (iii) if the officer is required to reside in the District of Columbia and the officer so resides – US\$10010; and
 - (iv) if the officer resides elsewhere in the United States of America – US\$7505."

Excess commuting costs - United States of America

4. Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as in force¹ is amended by -

- (a) omitting "US\$40" from sub-clause 186.1 and substituting "US\$47";
- (b) omitting "22.5 cents" from sub-clause 186.2 and substituting "26.4 cents"; and
- (c) omitting "22.5 cents" from sub-clause 186.3 and substituting "26.4 cents".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 64 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Part 3 of Determination 1989/27, Education Assistance – Members Posted Overseas, by deleting all reference to designated schools and substituting a monetary amount. This brings Manhattan Island into line with the process applying to schools throughout the USA. This determination also amends the current monetary amounts in Clause 18 by applying the latest increase in the US Consumer Price Index for Tuition and other schools. In addition, Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas is amended by increasing the amounts provided for excess commuting costs in accordance with CPI movements.

These provisions are in line with those determined for Australian Public Service staff directed to reside on Manhattan Island, USA.
