DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1991/67.

Principal Determination

2. In this determination Determination 3737, Medical and Hospital Expenses of a Member's Family Overseas, as in force¹ is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Commencement

3. This determination shall commence on 1 July 1991.

Reimbursement of excess medical costs

4. Sub-clause 7.1 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "\$A53" and substituting "\$A57".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 67 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 3737, Medical and Hospital Expenses of a Member's Family Overseas which prescribes the assistance available for hospital and medical services that applies to members while on overseas posting.

Sub-clause 7.1 provides for the reimbursement of costs for medical services in excess of specified amounts which were set in December 1990.

This determination increases the amount to be met by the member.

This determination flows on changes in the amounts applying to officers of the Australian Public Service.
