**Principal Determination**

2. In this determination Defence Determination 2002, Loss on Sale of Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas, as in force<sup>1</sup> is referred to as the Principal Determination.

**Loss on Sale of Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas**

- 3.1 Sub-clause 6.1 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "\$A1300" and substituting "\$A1325".
- 3.2 Sub-clause 7.1 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "\$A650" and substituting "\$A662".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

**DETERMINATION NO. 7 OF 1991**

Defence Act 1903

This determination amends Determination 2002, Loss on Sale of Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas.

This determination amends the maximum reimbursement limit for loss on sale of a motor vehicle applicable to members of the Australian Defence Force proceeding on long-term posting overseas in line with the revised limit determined for Australian Public Service staff in similar circumstances.
