DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Transitional - special rent rebates

2. A member to whom clause 7A of Determination 3721 applied immediately before its repeal is not required to pay a rent and utility contribution exceeding that which would have been required in accordance with that clause for the period that the clause would have applied to the member but for its repeal.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 75 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

Determination 3721, Rent and Utilities Contribution, requires members of the Australian Defence Forces to make a contribution for rent and utilities when the member is provided with accommodation by the Commonwealth.

Clause 7A of Determination 3721, which provided for reduced rates for members in specified localities, was repealed by sub-clause 11.1 of Overseas Defence Determination 1990/191. Overseas Defence Determination 1990/191 introduced revised arrangements for the remission of rent in certain circumstances.

The operation of sub-clause 11.1 had been deferred until 31 July 1991 to enable the new arrangements to be put in place. There is a need for a continuing transitional arrangement for members on posting as at 31 July 1991.

This determination will maintain the special rates for members on posting on 31 July 1991 until the end of the posting period.
