Recreation Leave

2. Determination 2601, Recreation Leave¹, is amended by omitting from clause 13 "a member who serves in a locality specified in column 1 of the following table" and substituting the following -

"a member who -

- (aa) serves in a locality specified in column 1 of the following table; and
- (ab) is not eligible for War Service Leave for service in that locality,".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO. 78 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, provides for the credit and granting of recreation leave. Clause 13 provides for an additional recreation leave credit where a member serves in specified Australian and overseas remote localities.

This determination amends Determination 2601 to preclude a member who is in receipt of War Service Leave for service in an operational area from also accruing a remote locality leave entitlement.
