



DETERMINATION NO 82 OF 1991

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

I, RUTH ALISON CAMPBELL, First Assistant Secretary, Remuneration and Conditions Division, Department of Industrial Relations, pursuant to a delegation made by the Minister of State for Industrial Relations under Defence Force Regulation 72A, hereby make the following determination under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1991/82.

Operation Blazer

2.1 A member who -

- (a) is on duty in Iraq with Operation Blazer; and
- (b) is directed to disarm, dismantle, transport or destroy weapons of mass destruction in Iraq,

is entitled to be paid an amount of \$A40.38 a day for each day, or part of a day, that the member performs those duties.

2.2 A member who is on duty in Iraq with Operation Blazer is entitled to be paid an amount of \$A28.38 a day for any day, or part of a day, on which the member is not entitled to be paid in accordance with sub-clause 2.1.

2.3 A member is not entitled to be paid in accordance with sub-clauses 2.1 and 2.2 for the same day.

Overseas allowances not payable

3. For the purposes of a determination, other than Determinations 2601 and 3601, a member who is entitled to be paid an amount under this determination is not to be taken, by reason only of being assigned for duty in Iraq with Operation Blazer, to be overseas for the period the member is so entitled.

Amount of travelling allowance to be reduced in certain circumstances

4. The amount of accommodation expenses and travelling allowance payable to a member assigned to Operation Blazer is to be reduced by the amount of United Nations Mission Subsistence Allowance payable to the member.

Transitional

5. A member who has been on duty with Operation Blazer during the whole or part of the inclusive period from 2 July 1991 until immediately before this determination comes into operation is entitled to be paid an allowance equal to the amount by which the amount the member would have been entitled to be paid if this determination had been in force during the whole or part of the period, as the case may be, exceeds the amount the member is entitled to be paid for accommodation expenses and travelling allowance for the period.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 82 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

This determination establishes the payment of an amount for ADF members participating in the United Nations operation involving the inspection and destruction of Iraqi weapons.

Clause 3 excludes concurrent payment of other overseas allowances where the member is overseas only in connection with Operation Blazer.

Clause 4 provides for the reduction of Travelling Allowance by the amount of United Nations Mission Subsistence Allowance received by the member.

Clause 5 provides for payment of a transitional allowance for the period 2 July 1991, the day the operation commenced, to the date on which this determination came into operation.
