EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 83 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 1990/190 was made on 24 December 1990 to authorise reimbursement to Reserve Force members of excess insurance premiums incurred as a result of service in an operational area. The determination was specifically intended to apply Reservist medical specialists serving in the Persian Gulf.

As the need for these provisions has now ceased, the determination is repealed by clause 2 of this determination.
