DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1991/89.

Principal Determination

2. In this determination Determination 3719, Post Allowance, as in force¹ is referred to as the Principal Determination.

Definitions

3. Clause 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "Difficult Post Allowance grade" from the definition of "post allowance grade" and substituting "Difficult Post grade".

Post Allowance

4. Sub-clause 4.1 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting "Schedule 3/T/A" and substituting "Schedule 5".

Short-term missions to China

5. The Principal Determination is amended by omitting clause 10A.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 89 OF 1991

Defence Act 1903

Determination 3719, Post Allowance (referred to as the Principal Determination), provides for the payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) who are required to perform duty at specified difficult posts overseas for a period of more than one month.

Overseas Defence Determination 1990/144 of 17 October 1990 amended the Principal Determination by deriving the rates of allowance and prescribed localities from the identical rates and localities applicable to officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) under Public Service Board Determination 1983/15, referred to as the relevant Public Service determination.

As a result of the revision of the Difficult Post Allowance provisions of the relevant Public Service determination by Public Service Determination 1991/226, it is necessary to make minor consequential amendments to two references in the Principal Determination.

Clause 3 of this determination amends the definition of "post allowance grade" to reflect the use of the term 'Difficult Post grade' in the relevant Public Service determination.

Clause 4 updates a reference to the schedule of localities, grades and rates in the relevant Public Service determination.

Clause 5 omits a clause authorising payment of Post Allowance Grade 1 to members on long-term posting in Hong Kong who undertake short-term missions to southern China. This provision is now redundant.
