



## **DETERMINATION NO 2 OF 1992**

### **DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903**

#### **Citation**

**1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1992/2.**

#### **Principal Determination**

**2. In this determination Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as in force<sup>1</sup> is referred to as the Principal Determination.**

**Household maintenance and assistance - Head, Australian Defence Staff**

3. The Principal Determination is amended by omitting clause 14 and substituting -

"14. For the purpose of applying the relevant Public Service determination to a member who performs duties as Head, Australian Defence Staff and occupies a residence at an address specified in column 1 of the Schedule, the limit of reimbursement applicable to the member is the amount specified in column 5 of Part C of Schedule 2A to that determination opposite the position and residential address specified in Column 2 of the Schedule."

**Schedule**

4. The Principal Determination is amended by omitting the Schedule and substituting the Schedule to this determination.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**  
**DETERMINATION NO 2 OF 1992**

***Defence Act 1903***

This determination amends the provisions in Determination 3901 providing for household maintenance and assistance to members on long term posting to the position of Head, Australian Defence Staff (HADS) in Washington D.C. and London.

The amendment applies the same limit of reimbursement as applies to equivalent members of the Australian Public Service with similar representational commitments.

This results in no immediate change in the limit of expenditure applicable to HADS, Washington and applies a slightly increased limit to HADS London.
