3. Clause 10 of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting from the table "269" and substituting "262".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DETERMINATION NO 66 OF 1992

Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 1992/58 of 4 December 1992 amended provisions for payment of Isolated Establishment Allowance and Disturbance Allowance for members of the Australian Defence Force. The amendments made by that Determination amended rates of allowance on the same basis as rates applying to officers of the Australian Public Service.

An incorrect figure was substituted in the table at Clause 10 of Determination 505, Disturbance Allowance - "Third and Fourth removal" (a rate which applies to members returning to Australia). This determination amends the Principal Determination by omitting the incorrect rate (\$269) and substituting the correct rate of allowance (\$262).
