DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1993/29.

Definition

2. In this determination "relevant Public Service determination" means Public Service Board Determination 1983/15 as in force from time to time.

Settling in and settling out - meal costs

3. A member is entitled to be paid meals supplement in relation to a period of settling in or settling out overseas in accordance with the relevant Public Service determination as if the member were an officer of the Australian Public Service in the same circumstances as the member.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DETERMINATION NO 29 OF 1993
Defence Act 1903

This determination sets out provisions relating to Settling In and Settling Out for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) serving overseas.

The provisions were formerly contained in Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out, which has been repealed by Overseas Defence Determination 1993/30.

This determination adopts by reference the identical entitlements provided overseas for officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) in Public Service Board Determination 1983/15 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*. Such adoption is authorised by subsection 58B(1A) of the *Defence Act 1903*.

The effect of the determination is that this condition of service is provided to ADF members travelling overseas as if they were APS officers.

Clause 2 defines a term used in the determination.

Clause 3 applies the entitlements on the same basis as for APS officers.
