EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DETERMINATION NO 4 OF 1993
Defence Act 1903

Determination 501, Education Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force who are posted from one locality to another locality within Australia and who arrange for their child to attend a secondary school in a locality other than the locality of posting to prevent serious interference to the child's secondary schooling.

'Serious interference' may occur where a member is posted at specified critical times during a child's education. One such time is during the year in which a public examination or similar assessment takes place.

The Schedule to Determination 501 specifies the public examination years and certificates or awards appropriate to each State or Territory.

This determination substitutes a revised Schedule reflecting updated names of various educational certificates issued by the States and Territories.
