



## OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1993/48

### DETERMINATION UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

#### 1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1993/48.

#### 2. Commencement

2.1 This Determination commences on the day on which Overseas Defence Determination 1993/47 commences.

#### 3. Repeal

3.1 Determination 3702, Transfer Allowance, as amended<sup>1</sup>, is repealed.

#### **4. Transitional**

4.1 A member who was entitled to be paid Transfer Allowance during the period commencing on 4 December 1993 and ending on the day on which this Determination commences is entitled to be paid additional Transfer Allowance equal to the amount by which the Transfer Allowance to which the member was entitled is exceeded by the amount to which the member would have been entitled if Overseas Defence Determination 1993/47 had been in force during the period.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1993/48**

*Defence Act 1903*

Overseas Defence Determination 1993/47 sets out provisions relating to Transfer Allowance for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) on long-term posting overseas. That Determination operates by reference to rates and conditions of payment provided for officers of the Australian Public Service in Public Service Board (PSB) Determination 1983/15.

The ADF provisions were formerly contained in Determination 3702, Transfer Allowance.

Clause 2 of this Determination provides for the Determination to commence on the same day as Overseas Defence Determination 1993/47.

Clause 3 repeals Determination 3702.

Clause 4 sets out a transitional arrangement under which a member is entitled to receive, in relation to the specified period, the higher rates of Transfer Allowance inserted into PSB Determination 1983/15 with effect from 4 December 1993 by Public Service Determination 1993/171 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*.
