1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/13.

2. Indemnity for loss or damage arising from removal within Australia

2.1 A member who is granted a removal within Australia is entitled to be indemnified by the Commonwealth for any loss or damage to furniture or household effects arising from removal or storage -

- (a) in the case of a member with the rank of Brigadier or a higher rank - in accordance with Public Service Board Determination 1984/46 as in force from time to time; and
- (b) in any other case - in accordance with Public Service Board Determination 1983/10 as in force from time to time,

as if the member were an officer of the Australian Public Service.

DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/13

Defence Act 1903

This Determination adopts by reference for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) the compensation limit set by the Commonwealth for Australian Public Service (APS) staff for loss or damage to furniture and household effects arising from a removal.
