1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/14.

2. Commencement

2.1 This Determination is to be taken to have commenced on 1 April 1994.

3. Amendment

3.1 Defence Determination 1993/35 is amended as set out in this Determination.

4. Clause 2 (Special Royal Navy Allowance)

4.1 Paragraph 2.1(a):

Delete "Pound Stg 4.25", "Pound Stg 8.47" and "Pound Stg 107.59", substitute "Pound Stg 4.40", "Pound Stg 8.80" and "Pound Stg 112.00" respectively.

4.2 Paragraph 2.1(b):

Delete "Pound Stg 8.47" and "Pound Stg 210.10", substitute "Pound Stg 8.80" and "Pound Stg 218.00" respectively.

4.3 Paragraph 2.1(c):

Delete "Pound Stg 8.47" and "Pound Stg 420.21", substitute "Pound Stg 8.80" and "Pound Stg 436.00" respectively.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/14

Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 1993/35 provides for payment of an allowance for experimental dives or submarine escape trials conducted by certain members of the Royal Australian Navy serving overseas with the Royal Navy.

The amendments made by this Determination authorise increased rates of the allowance with effect from 1 April 1994 in line with rates determined for Royal Navy members from the same date.

The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
