**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/16**

*Defence Act 1903*

Determination 404, Isolated Establishment Allowance (IEA), provides for payment of IEA to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) serving in certain establishments that are isolated from urban residential areas, on a similar basis to the IEA payable to officers of the Australian Public Service (APS).

This Determination amends Determination 404 by increasing the special ADF rates of IEA in Schedules 1 and 2 on the same basis as the rates applying to officers of the APS. These changes in rates apply from 10 March 1994, the same date as increases in the rates of the equivalent APS allowance made by Public Service Determination 1994/25.

The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
