EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/17
Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 1992/30 established special conditions for Australian Defence Force members assigned for duty with the *United Nations Military Liaison Office - Yugoslavia* or the *United Nations Protection Force in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Montenegro, Serbia, Slovenia and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia*.

As no members are now assigned for such duty as part of an Australian deployment, the Principal Determination is repealed by this Determination.
