### 1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/22.

### 2. Commencement

2.1 This Determination commences on 1 July 1994.

### 3. Amendment

3.1 Determination 2507, Charge for Excess Water, as amended<sup>1</sup>, is amended as set out in this Determination.

### 4. Clause 3 (Charge for excess water)

4.1 Delete "\$2.20 a fortnight", substitute "\$2.80 a fortnight".

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**  
**DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/22**  
*Defence Act 1903*

Determination 2507, Charge for Excess Water, allows for a deduction to cover the cost of excess water of a uniform amount each fortnight from the salary of members of the Australian Defence Force who reside in married quarters.

This Determination amends Determination 2507 to increase the charge from \$2.20 to \$2.80 a fortnight with effect from 1 July 1994.

The level of excess water charges continues to be based on Australia-wide charges incurred by the Defence Housing Authority. The adjustment made by this Determination reflects the increased level of excess water charges incurred to date during this financial year.
