**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/24**

*Defence Act 1903*

Defence Determination 202, Separation Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force who live away from their families for specified periods.

This Determination amends Determination 202 by removing two unnecessary interpretation provisions.

One related to "de facto spouse" has been overtaken by the general definition of "spouse" provided in clause 3 of Defence Determination 1991/45.

The other related to references to determinations was not needed to permit the proper operation of Determination 202.
